

## Men's Grillin -N- Chillin Official Rules 2019

1. This year will have 2 Grillin categories and 1 Chillin category: Best BBQ and Most Unique and Best Chili. A pre-selected panel of judges will decide "**Best BBQ**" based on flavor, tenderness, and overall presentation as well as "**Best Chili**". The "**Most Unique**" category will be judged by your peers and the people...so give the people what they want.
2. Your crew should consist of **4 or so males (any age)** who must all participate in the cooking of your food – we strongly urge you to include new people in this year's event, as well as youth.
3. **Food may be prepared offsite (like marinating), but the meal must be cooked onsite in the parking lot of GCF.** Participants are responsible for bringing grills, camping stoves, and even girly crock-pots to the church on Saturday.
4. **No women can participate** in the preparation, cooking, or serving of your food. Period. We'll use the honor system for this rule, but if you are found cheating, your man card may be revoked.
5. **You must prepare enough food for 65 people to test.** Test sample sizes are up to you, but we will provide a small sample cup or plate that will only hold a couple ounces.

**NOTE: If your entry is not turned in within 5 minutes of your given time you will forfeit competing for the Best BBQ award as chosen by the judges.**

6. **Teams may enter up to 3 items total, (no more than 2 Grillin and 1 Chillin)** but you are responsible for the supplies for each entry. Each item entered will be voted on individually.
7. There will be a *two types of judging in BBQ category* (Best BBQ and Most Unique) for a total of 2 possible awards.- **JUDGE'S CHOICE** (Best BBQ) - We will have a small panel of judges who will award the top prize in the category based on taste, quality, and awesomeness.- **PEOPLE'S CHOICE** (Most Unique) - Everyone in attendance will have the opportunity to judge for this award as long as they do not have an entry personally. To be able to judge, people must taste every item in that category.

There will *one type of judging in the Chili category* (Best Chili), Everyone will still be able to taste and sample your chili entry, but evaluation will only come from judges.

8. All entries for "Best BBQ" and "Best Chili" must be turned in **no later than 5:30pm** for judging or you forfeit the category (NO EXCEPTIONS). Most Unique must be plated and ready to serve no later than 6:15pm
9. Every team is responsible for discarding of their coals and ashes from bbq grills and pits **OFF** church property.
10. Pastor Brandon is the final authority on the interpretation of the rules - stated or unstated.
